a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal for the funds being requested is ensuring the safety and security of elections office operations and providing registered voters with safety through protection of their identifiable and personal data.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The activities provided by the program include endpoint detection and response of cybersecurity risks; security information and event monitoring; and obtaining and maintaining cloud infrastructure that will serve as the operational system of each fiscally constrained counties' voter registration data system.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The program will provide security and stewardship of personal and identifiable voter registration information through the protection of the data system that holds and maintains such data.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population for this program are the twenty-nine rural and fiscally constrained counties and all of the registered voters of such counties.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit of the program is to ensure fiscally constrained counties have adequate data security and continuity of operations.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?
