JARC will work with local businesses to secure partnerships for the community-based employment training. Individuals with intellectual disabilities and autism will receive job coaching services.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Participants in the program will be provided the opportunity to receive community-based employment training at local businesses. This will be completed with supervision from trained job coaches to maximize the potential for independent employment.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This program provides services to individuals with intellectual disabilities and autism. We also provide support to the families of the individuals receiving services. The program has grown every year, and currently provides services to 85 individuals and their families.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

A minimum of 30 participants will receive a training in how to develop a resume and how to interact in a job interview. With a goal of community-based employment, a minimum of 6 individuals will become employed by the partner businesses. Outcomes will be measured by the number of partner businesses and the number of individuals employed.
