Increase access to drowning prevention, education and resources to reduce the number of drownings in the state.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Water Safety & swim lessons that have specific tactics to teach students to be safe in and around the water. Community awareness campaigns through strengthening drowning prevention task forces. A Statewide marketing campaign geared to teach citizens about supervision, use of barriers, learn to swim and rescue.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Water safety/swim lessons, education materials, and local drowning prevention support through local drowning prevention task forces.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Elderly persons, Persons with poor physical health, Economically disadvantaged persons, At-risk youth, Developmentally disabled, Physically disabled, Preschool students, Grade school students, and High school students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefit is to have more kids that are equipped with drowning prevention strategies. Participants will be tested at the start and end of the program. The number that pass will serve as the measurement.
