a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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To replace approximately 3,900 linear feet of failing watermain infrastructure with new 6-inch and 8-inch Certa-Lok C900 watermain pipe, new water service connections that provide clean drinking water to citizens, and installation of new fire hydrant assemblies that will provide improvements to fire protection for City residents living on Cedar St, Pine St, Spruce St and MLK Jr St, within the three City communities of Lincoln Heights, Washington Square, and Lincoln Highlands Subdivisions.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Activities and services provided with the project are the replacement of failing watermain infrastructure with a new watermain pipe, new water service connections to homes, and installation of new fire hydrant assemblies. Also, the new system will loop water mains that are currently a dead-end system, as required by City Code.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The direct service of the project will improve and replace watermains that service clean drinking water to citizens. Also, the new water main infrastructure will provide improved fire protection service with the replacement of old fire hydrant assemblies.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target Population served by this project are City of Safety Harbor residents. More than 800 residential homes.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit of the project will improve and replace watermains that service clean drinking water to City residents. The new system will provide a looped watermain that is currently a dead-end system, as required by City Land Development Code. Also, the new watermain infrastructure will provide improved fire protection service with the replacement of old fire hydrant assemblies.
