#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The FGUA proposes replace the existing septic tanks in the Seven Springs Service Area, particularly the Riverside Village subdivision which is located in the Anclote River Freshwater segment identified by FDEP as water not meeting standards for E.Cole. The project will eliminate sewage seepage due to low lying area and high water table and will eliminate septic tank back-ups into homes from inoperable drain fields thus eliminating nutrient loading in stormwater, groundwater, and surface water and eliminating the bacterial health risk in the area.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction of sewer lines to service the homes as well as abandonment of the septic tanks currently serving the homes.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Construction of sewer lines to serve the homes therefore eliminating septic tank back-ups from inoperable/failing drain fields due to low lying area and high water table; abandonment of the septic tanks currently serving the homes. Residents will receive sewer service without concern for septic tank maintenance or pumping issues.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Riverside Village Community. 101-200 residents, estimated.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Elimination of septic tanks and their back-ups into homes from inoperable/failing drain fields. Wastewater will be being directly sent to the wastewater treatment plant .Sampling of drainage swales to ensure there is further sewage seepage.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Liquidated damages charged to contractor for failing to meet construction deadlines or breach of contract terms.
