This project is intended to support the emerging scholarship at USF in the area of rare diseases by enabling the university to adjust to the needs of top tier scientific projects.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds research related start up costs, such as initial lab costs, that include equipment as well as lab technical personnel. Part of bringing any research to an institution is demonstrating the capacity to undertake the particular work proposed.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Increasing access to rare disease treatments, by expanding clinical trials, and translating disease discovery into bedside treatments within an existing population of patients.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Floridians who suffer from rare diseases and genetic disorders and university students and researchers. Millions of individuals statewide could benefit from this research.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Reducing suffering and improving quality of life are the primary goals of this type of science. Reducing the lag time from discovery to treatment is the measure.
