Village staff will use VAC trucks to keep drainage systems free of debris and cloggage, preventing sanitary sewer overflow, and mitigating potential environmental incidents.

The target population served by this project is the general population of North Bay Village. Given that the population of North Bay Village is just over 8,000 residents, it is fair to assume this Emergency and Municipal Complex will serve approximately 15,000 residents including several thousand that visit relatives and businesses in the municipality.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Potential reduction in sanitary sewer overflow occurrences. Amount of debris removed can be weighed to show improvement in maintenance of drainage systems.
