a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The utilities of Gulf County Sheriff's Office are exposed and accessible from a public alley. Rerouting the alley and additional fencing are required to secure the generator and other utilities used by the Sheriff's Office and our Communications Center. Engineering costs and construction of storm water diversion are also needed. To expand the functionality of the property we plan to pave, fence and build secure storage for our fleet, traffic trailers and specialized emergency vehicles. These enclosures would secure and prevent further deterioration of our assets.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The purpose of this project is to harden the exterior of the Gulf County Sheriff's Office and develop a storage/impound yard to house our fleet and specialized emergency vehicles. The security of the building will allow us to provide public safety services to the citizens of Gulf County. The storage/impound yard will prevent deterioration of our assets and save tax dollars on replacement costs.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The hardening of the building will ensure that public safety services will not be interrupted due to vandalism or accidents that may compromise the generator or other utilities of the Sheriff's Office and our Communications Center. Properly stored and functional emergency vehicles will allow us to maintain operational readiness to promptly respond to incidents and keep our citizens safe.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General population and visitors of Gulf County, which can be over 30,000 depending on the amount of visitors in the county.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Maintain an operational Sheriff's Office and Communications Center, free from disruption of services due to power failure or other utility issues. Respond to incidents in a timely fashion utilizing specialized emergency vehicles that are properly stored in a safe environment that will prevent deterioration and mechanical failure. Monitor the frequency of disruptions in service to the Sheriff's Office and Communications Center building during severe weather events. Analyze expenditures for emergency vehicle repairs due to vehicle deterioration caused by exposure to the elements. Also analyze vehicle life and functionality when properly stored in a secure building.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to spend funds as indicated in the contract would result in funds being returned to the state.
