With the completion of the new Liberty County Sheriff's Office Administrative Complex and Jail expected to take place in the summer of 2025, the current jail could be renovated into a judicial complex. This complex would allow for all judicial partners including the County Judges Office, Clerk's Office, Circuit Felony Judge, Circuit Civil Judge, State Attorney, Public Defender, State Probation, and County Probation to be housed in one location directly adjacent to the courthouse.
