14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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This project would include converting a portion of their wastewater system from sewer force-main with grinder stations to a more economical gravity sewer system. By replacing the pressure sewer system with a gravity system, the existing grinder pumps can be removed from each house, thus reducing energy consumption and repeated maintenance of the grinder pumps. This project was partially funded in 2021 through the CDBG-DR General Infrastructure program through DEO and the portion being requested now will be in an effort to replace the remaining areas of low pressure force-main and grinder stations in the City and convert them to gravity sewer. The Bird Pond Road residents on grinder stations have always had an increasingly tough time to keep their residential sewer sanitary and the topic of the costly maintenance of these grinder pumps has been a point of contention between the citizens that own the pumps and the City of Bristol.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The direct services of this project are a more economical and reliable sewer system. In the weeks following Hurricane Michael these pumps were a source of ground contamination and unsanitary conditions. With water service immediately available, but power service unavailable, the pump stations (which require electricity) at these residences would overflow and raw sewage would pour freely onto the ground within feet of the occupied residential structures.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This will provide conversion of all low pressure force-main and grinder stations in the City and convert them to gravity sewer.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will benefit the entire City of Bristol, approximately 915 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

By replacing the pressure sewer system with a gravity system, the existing grinder pumps can be removed from each house, thus reducing energy consumption and repeated maintenance of the grinder pumps.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The Auditor General audits for both the Town and State agencies. If the project is not completed within the requirements outlined in the grant award, the funding may be withdrawn.
