To reduce phosphorus loads into Timberlane Creek, this project includes a culvert enlargement under Timberlane Road, a new stormwater pond, channel stabilization, and other drainage improvements.

This project will protect one of Florida's highly threatened surface water bodies by providing new drainage improvements which will enhance environmental quality through improved stormwater and surface water management.
