Additionally, the funding will provide for roadway improvements to alleviate the traffic concerns, currently creating a safety hazard in the vicinity of the school's campus.

Extended service with respect to the County's wastewaster system and roadway improvements.

This project reduces potential exposure to wastewater from compromised and failing septic tank systems, will lead to removal of nutrient and bacterial sources of pollution from septic tank effluent, and reduces safety hazard to students an pedestrians in the area through roadway improvements. Benefits can be measured by number of septic tanks removed as well as number of accidents for the two different aspects of the project, respectively.
