construction components include: reconstruction of existing catch basins, additional catch basins, manholes, culverts, exfiltration trench, introduction of sediment traps, and connection to the SFWMD C-100



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The project is prioritized in Village's Stormwater Master Plan, adopted during a public meeting where public input was received. The plan is available on the Village website and its elements are incorporated into the Comprehensive Plan, which is also adopted by public meeting. Project is based on resident complaints of flooding, field inspections performed by Public Services and the consultant

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction and improvement to existing catch basins. The project will control flooding and other hazards associated with stormwater surges. The flood stages determined by the current Sub-Basin 11 exceed allowable levels and the subbasin does not meet the performance goal criteria.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The improvement to the existing catch basins and the introduction of new catch basins will allow the Village to keep roadways clear during stormwater events. Furthermore, minimizing water collection on the roadways will preserve the integrity of the roads.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Sub-basin #11 is part of the C100-N-11 Miami-Dade County basin. Improvements to this sub-basin will have wide reaching impacts.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The Village's 2020 Stormwater Master Plan estimates the following pollutant reductions:

Phosphorous - Existing load: 28.75 kg/yr Proposed load: 2.11 kg/yr Nitrogen -- Existing load: 226.51 kg/yr Proposed load: 23.78 kg/yr Suspended solids - Existing load: 2,715.24 kg/yr Proposed load: 256.59 kg/yr

The Village will work with appropriate agencies to monitor the pollutants and other environmental improvements as a result of the Sub-basin #11 project. The Village will document the number of complaints reported in regard to flooding and hazardous conditions that may pose a threat to public health & safety property & the environment (quarterly). The Village will continue to inspect outfalls (annually).
