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14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose is to demolish existing non-operational generator, then design and install a backup generator to serve the entire Courthouse in the event of power outages in order to keep the Courthouse functioning during extended power outages and emergency conditions.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Dixie County Courthouse accommodates the following offices: Tax Collector, Clerk of Court, Property Appraiser, Sheriff Office, Board Operations, Judges Chambers, and Court Room Facilities.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This project will allow the courthouse to have uninterrupted services during times the main power goes out for the building. When Hurricane Idalia hit the area, the courthouse was closed for nine (9) days just before and following the storm due to the fact that the main power was shut down and the current generator system was non-operational. Court cases had to be rescheduled, the Sheriff had to work out of a different location, and other county business had to be postponed until the building was able to reopen with power from the mainline.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is 17,000+ people, including all citizens and surrounding areas, as well as the employees working out of the Dixie County Courthouse.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Once the project is complete, the expected outcome is to maintain normal courthouse process during inclement weather, and provide public services regardless of power outages from the main power source.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?
