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Our entrepreneurial ecosystem has yielded significant results, including the launch of successful startups, creating highwage jobs with an average salary of more than \$79,000 (3x the per capita income in our area), and technological innovations. However, to continue this trajectory and maximize the ecosystem's potential, we are requesting recurring state funding to sustain existing programs, expand our reach, increase impact, promote research and innovation, and enhance workforce development.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Embry-Riddle is deeply committed to nurturing the entrepreneurial spirit within our university and the broader community. Recurring state funding will be instrumental in ensuring we can expand support, and opportunities to our students, faculty and staff as well as entrepreneurs, innovators, and businesses that fuel economic growth and progress. In addition, the Research Park is a hotspot for research and development (R&D) activities. The growth of R&D within the park increases overall R&D expenditure in the state. This expenditure is a critical driver of technological progress, industry innovation, and competitive advantage. It positions the state as a hub for research excellence, attracting further investments and opportunities.
