a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The requested funds will primarily achieve the vital goal of enhancing the safety and reliability of the Town's water and sewer systems. Specifically, the project will replace or rehabilitate vulnerable water and sewer mains, preventing emergency repairs and dangerous situations. This effort aims to eliminate sanitary sewer overflows, improve environmental quality, and increase the overall efficiency and reliability of the water and sewer infrastructure. The funds will support critical components such as engineering design, permitting, and construction activities necessary for achieving these objectives.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The requested funds will support essential activities for improving the Town's water and sewer systems, including engineering design, permitting, and construction tasks such as lining sewer mains, replacing lines, and rehabilitating manholes. Engineering services during construction will ensure effective oversight. These efforts collectively aim to enhance safety and reliability by addressing vulnerabilities in the infrastructure, preventing emergencies, and achieving overall system improvement.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The appropriation project directly benefits citizens by ensuring improved and reliable water and sewer services. It prevents sanitary sewer overflows, reduces the risk of emergencies, and enhances overall system efficiency. This translates into more dependable services, reduced disruptions, and a cleaner local environment for residents, contributing to economic well-being and supporting local businesses.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this project includes the residents and businesses within the Town relying on the water and sewer systems. With a population of 1,373 individuals, the project aims to directly benefit this community by providing improved and reliable water and sewer services. The infrastructure enhancements will contribute to the well-being and safety of the entire population, ensuring a more stable and efficient water and sewer system for their daily needs.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project aims to improve water and sewer system reliability, reducing disruptions, enhancing fire flow capabilities, and decreasing documented sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs) and backups, particularly during rainfall or storms. Success will be measured through tracking system reliability, monitoring sewer overflow occurrences, assessing fire flow capabilities, and conducting regular environmental evaluations.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Non Payment of Invoices; Performance and Payment Bonds will be required to complete the work. Penalty would include use of these bonding documents.
