14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This program will recruit and train a Cohort of 15 historically underrepresented individuals per quarter (youth aging out of the foster care system, veterans, Native Americans, etc. for an Engineering/Maintenance Technician Program. Our unique work-study program is a 12 week interpersonal & technical skills training program. Upon successful completion of the IS & technical phase, Program participants will be interviewed at various manufacturing companies and gain employment.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

BLT LLC. will provide services to train and develop quality manufacturing engineering/maintenance/production technicians. The curriculum is 144 total hours with the blending of interpersonal skills and technical skills to ensure sustainability. These services include working with manufacturing & trades industries to provide quality, living wage + jobs. Targeted sourcing will reach the underrepresented and the data retrieved will assist us to grow, evaluate and reach more people each year.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This Industrial Skills Initiative will provide interpersonal skills and technical skills activities including software & practical simulations, role plays, hands on labs and class room training. Resume writing & interviewing skills will also be practiced. The curriculum is 144 total hours with the cross between interpersonal skills and technical skills.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This program will recruit and train a Cohort of 15 historically underrepresented individuals per quarter (youth aging out of the foster care system, veterans, Native Americans, etc. for an Engineering/Maintenance Technician Program.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit will be citizens will be more productive by using their newly gained knowledge and skills. Many of these types of positions pay more than minimum wage and participants will have access to housing, increased schooling, economic development and taking care of their families. 90% of the 60 participants are employed within the first 60 days of the end of program. 60% employed in the field of Production, Maintenance, ET data from the Mechatronics Training System and the Z Space Software Training. Use of surveys from companies regarding preparation with employees received from BLT trained employees vs. other employees received through their application process.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Penalties include restricted access for upskill manufacturing training to improve economic self-sufficiency, higher crime rate and stability. Statistics show that the lack of training and education for families lead to impoverished areas. The DoD shows lacking these skills are a threat to National Security. The McKinsey Opportunity Index shows a 5% decrease in optimism regarding upskill opportunities within the past 2 years, which will continue to grow without these upskill opportunities.
