14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Administrative duties not covered under contractual nor fee-for-service funding streams but which are necessary for the continuation of the mental health services both in maintaining the requirements of the specific funding streams as well as consistently making payroll of those direct service providers. Securing of additional monies so that all positions are not funded by the State long term. CGC is re-applying to be a CCBHC as well as attempting to grow our own private donor pool through assistance via grants.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Billing, report writing, contractual responsiveness, increased dollars coming in under private donors and grants. CGC provides mental health services to children, adolescents, and families but cannot continue to operate under the low administrative percentage which is allowable under state and fee for service funding rules. We are attempting to grow a stronger donor base to assist us in an ever-growing population of lower SES and at-risk children in the Duval County area. These positions will prepare us for a stronger CCBHC application and will be written into that application for the long term.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This funding would provide the necessary back office administrative support for our front line direct service providers for both fee for service and contract mental health services. This would ensure appropriate reports required for funding streams, yet not covered as allowable expenses, would be created, maintained and provided for funding to be released.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

CGC serves over 4,000 children and their family members (>10,000 clients) on an annual basis. CGC provides mental health services to children, adolescents, and families. The ability to maintain contracts and funding streams is imperative to CGC remaining in the community (since 1951) to provide mental health services to an at-risk population not served by other organizations.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Administrative duties not covered under contractual nor fee-for-service funding streams but which are necessary for the continuation of the mental health services by maintaining the funding stream requirements of consistent reports necessary to draw down contracted money to secure direct service providers.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Funding will be returned to the State if positions are not filled.
