Enhanced lighting with low energy LED light fixtures, dugout modifications to allow for direct line of site of children for parents and coaches.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Francis Athletic Park is utilized by Palatka Babe Ruth for its baseball program which runs enrollment of 300+ youth per season, Peniel Baptist Academy's youth baseball program as well as numerous local travel team organizations. Youth sports and athletics is a proven resource to engage community youth in activities which directly support their physical, emotional and mental health and wellbeing.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All citizens of Putnam County as well as visitors to the county will be served by this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Project will benefit physical and mental health, cultural experience through community involvement, increased tourism, and reduction of substance abuse.
