Palatka Police Department's fleet of 40 police cruisers is at the end of its useful life as the cruisers must be replaced every 5 years. This funding would purchase 10 or (25%) of the necessary vehicles needed along with all the necessary equipment required in the cruiser. The entire fleet is paced to need replacement over the next four (4) years at 10 cars per year. The City is respectfully requesting funding for the first year of replacement.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Police Patrol cars are used by police officers to patrol a beat, quickly reach incident scenes, and transport and temporarily detain suspects, all while establishing a police presence and providing visible crime deterrence for the safety of the citizens.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The direct services include reliable police response during emergencies and regular police presence during patrols.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The targeted population served by this project would be economically disadvantaged persons, victims of crime, and the general population.
