To make a transformational difference in the lives of single parents in high stress careers (Florida National Guard, Law Enforcement, First Responders) and single parent veterans so they can raise healthy, well-equipped children.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

An immersive weekend workshop as well as a detailed 16-week support initiative and ongoing solo parent group opportunities.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Provide single parents in high stress careers and single parent veterans with resources that focus on their physical, emotional and spiritual needs, as well as, connect them to one another in authentic support communities.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Single parents in the Florida National Guard, Law Enforcement or First Responders as well as single parent veterans. Over 800 single parents will be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Improve the well-being of single parents in high stress careers and single parent veterans with resources and community so they can excel at the dual demands of solo parenthood and service/career. This will be measured by surveying participants.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The executed contract will govern penalties and any unspent funds will be returned to the agency.
