c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Education programs for high school students that allow students to earn industry certifications or post-secondary credit, secure internships/apprenticeships or post-graduation employment, and/or enlist in military careers promote the development of a sustainable career-ready workforce in cybersecurity fields. This is a direct benefit to the Seminole County community and the State of Florida.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

At risk, high school students & students with Limited English Proficiency and/or Disabilities.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increase the number of graduates from Seminole County Public Schools who identify cybersecurity as their career pathway; increase number of graduates who earn industry certifications and post-secondary credit related to cybersecurity; increase the number of graduates employed in the cybersecurity field post-graduation; increase the number of students who enlist seeking careers in cybersecurity. Increase the number of graduates from Seminole County Public Schools who successfully complete the cybersecurity program and indicate an intent to seek enrollment, enlistment, or employment in the high-skill, high-wage field of cybersecurity.
