Bradford County (County) has a goal to replace two apparatus in an aging fire engine fleet. All of our front-line apparatus were handed down from the previous volunteer fire departments. The County's front-line fleet has been plagued with costly repairs and extended down time. Over the past year, County crews have spent the majority of their time on the spare apparatus fleet, which includes one engine from 1998, and two engines from 2000. Safety and reliability have vastly improved over the past 23 years.

The new engines will mark a significant enhancement in the ability to reliably deliver high-quality fire and medical response. This will be measured by tracking response times and repair / maintenance costs.

Improved apparatus reliability will result in reduced response times, meaning we have the opportunity to prevent wildfires from decimating entire planted trees or crops. This will be measured by tracking annual total acres burned.
