15. Requester Contact Information

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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds will be used for construction of the new Environmental & Oceanographic Sciences Research & Teaching Facility at the USF St. Petersburg campus. This project is designed to be phased with activities combining new construction and renovation efforts to most efficiently meet university needs. \$24.34 million in PECO funds were appropriated by the Legislature and approved by Gov. DeSantis towards this project during FY 23-24.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

These funds will pay for facility construction of the remodel and new additional teaching laboratories, study space, campus support space, research laboratories and auditorium/exhibition space and associated fixtures, furnishings and equipment.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This facility will house individuals conducting nationally-renowned research in environmental and oceanographic sciences. High-achieving, cross-disciplinary USF students will be obtaining their degrees in marine and environmental sciences and other STEM undergraduate & graduate level programs offered within the facility.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

University/college students and faculty. The >50,000 USF students can utilize this facility.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expand undergraduate and graduate programs in marine and environmental sciences and other high-demand STEM areas at USF. Increased students graduating with high-demand undergraduate and/or graduate degrees to fill critical workforce needs. Increased marine and environmental science and STEM programs will produce additional graduates that can be placed in

high-deman'd jobs. More job placements in environmental, oceanographic, marine and other science fields. Greater amounts of research contracts and grants expenditures and R&D productivity by USF in the marine and environmental sciences.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

This is a PECO facilities request overseen by the Board of Governors of the State University System according to their regulations and statutory oversight which provide by law the penalties for noncompliance.
