Residents in this community reside mostly in mobile homes and are required to evacuate. This facility will also serve as a local voting polling place along with community events.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Funds to be used for contractual preliminary engineering, design, permitting, bidding, project management and construction services through the County's procurement policies and procedures.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services to citizens is protection and improved life, health and safety with a safe, secure local facility for shelter and to evacuate during storm events.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population is Palmdale residents and surrounding areas of Glades County, which is designated as a Rural Area of Opportunity, a financially disadvantaged community. Expected to be served is greater than 300.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefit is completed design and construction of safe, secure Public Safety Hardened Community Facility to protect life, health and safety in this Rural Area of Opportunity. Certification of the project.
