a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Okeechobee Utility Authority (OUA) is seeking funding assistance for hardening improvements to their operations located in a historic main office building that was constructed in 1915, originally serving as the People's Bank of Okeechobee. Funds will be used to replace old entryways, roof replacement, ADA compliance improvements, painting, telephone, electrical, data networks, etc.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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To seek contractual services through the OUA procurement policies and procedures for resiliency hardening improvements needed for protection of personnel, customers, records and for efficient and effective services and operations, which are conducted in a 1915 building, which originally served as the People's Bank of Okeechobee.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Improvements allow for citizens to safely utilize OUA services via walk-in or drive through service to make utility payments, open/close accounts and undertake related business and for the protection of personnel during daily operations.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Citizenry, visitors, tourists, City and County residents, Greater than 40,000
