In order to provide quality educational environments for the students at Woodlawn Elementary, permanent buildings are necessary. In addition, these new permanent classrooms will provide a safe learning environment for our students.

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The district will be able to provide a quality and safer environment for the students to learn.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The targeted population are elementary students at Woodlawn Elementary. The new classroom wing will serve approximately 236 student stations. Woodlawn Elementary offers Kindergarten thru 5th grade.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Permanent buildings are essential to provide a quality educational environment. 12 classrooms of students would benefit from this project. Safety is a top priority for the School Board of Highlands County and these new permanent structures will ensure a safer environment for the students currently housed in the relocatables due to over-capacity in their current school.

Woodlawn Elementary serves 778 students, with 82% economically disadvantaged. This is one of our schools that serves the highest population of migrant students in our district.
