The specific purpose to be achieved by the requested funds is to improve the resilience and safety of the road infrastructure in south Oldsmar, particularly in the special flood hazard area of upper Tampa Bay, through road resurfacing, sidewalk installation/rehabilitation, and the installation of traffic control devices, markings, and signage.

The funds will be used to renovate road infrastructure, including resurfacing roads, installing and rehabilitating sidewalks, and adding traffic control devices, markings, and signage in south Oldsmar.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The appropriation project will directly provide citizens with safer and more accessible roads through road resurfacing, improved pedestrian pathways, and enhanced traffic control measures, ensuring smoother and safer daily commutes as well as faster emergency response.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Local residents, businesses, tourists, and those businesses looking to relocate to Oldsmar. Over 1,500 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit of the project, which focuses on roadway improvements, is the enhancement of transportation infrastructure, leading to smoother traffic flow, reduced accidents, faster emergency response and improved accessibility for citizens in south Oldsmar. This outcome will be measured through objective metrics like reduced traffic congestion, response time, fewer road accidents, and increased pedestrian safety, assessed through traffic data analysis and safety reports.
