c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services provided to citizens would include support for the school provide physical fitness classes, athletic team practices, games, tournaments, community events and a safe space for a storm shelter and provided space for additional grades being added to the school.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by the building the exterior of the gymnasium/upper school building includes 900+ students from VPK to high school. Additionally, by expanding the campus to include a gym and upper school building, the surrounding community can be served with events as well as be used as a storm shelter.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The exterior gym building will allow our students to be more physically active which will lead to better grades, academic performance, attendance, classroom behaviors, and school morale. Physical fitness has shown to improve learning in reading, math, and writing skills. It will also allow the athletic teams the ability to practice and compete in sports without having to long travel to rented spaces. The school will conduct physical challenges, such as those found within the presidents physical fitness test, at the beginning and the end of the school year in order to track improvements. Survey the students and parents will also be utilized throughout the year.
