a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Goal is to dredge & widen the remaining 6-1/4 miles navigational channel & construct the embankment for the linear park which will improve water flow and filtration, resulting in cleaner water, and safer navigation. Glades County owns the largest area of Lake Okeechobee and access to the Lake is important to the economy. The Moore Haven Canal is the life line for the County that allows direct access to the Lake. Project provides for protection of State water resources, the public, tourists, visitors, citizenry & residents. Allows direct access to the Lake for revenue producing venues to be hosted for fishing, duck hunting, bird watching, hiking, wildlife enthusiasts & activities, etc. Addresses permitting agencies regulations, maintenance & reporting requirements.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds to be used for contractual engineering and construction services through the County's procurement policy to dredge and widen 1.5 miles of the remaining 6-1/4 mile channel and construct the embankment for the linear park. Tasks are engineering, design survey, soil analysis, permitting, photogrammetry, hydrologic modeling, bidding, earthwork, dewatering, turbidity control, water quality monitoring, mitigation planting, seeding, mulching and planting along the channel embankments, installing navigational aids, clearing and grubbing, wildlife surveys, maintenance of traffic for boaters, record surveys, final quantities, project management, etc.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services to citizens and tourists is for safer navigational waterways with direct access to the Lake, protection of State water resources, improved water flow and water quality, use and enjoyment of linear park.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population is Glades County, which is designated as a Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern, financially disadvantaged community, the citizenry, visitors, residents, tourists, boating and fishing industry and the State. Greater than 12,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit/outcome to complete the widening and deepening of the 7-mile navigational channel that provides for safer navigation, improved water flow and filtration, local access to Lake Okeechobee for Glades residents, tourists, citizenry, etc. Provides for direct access to the Lake allowing for economic stabilization and development for activities such as local events to be hosted for fishing, boaters, duck hunters, bird watching, hiking, wildlife enthusiasts, etc.; increases tourism and State revenues; maintains employment. Addresses permitting agencies requirements, maintenance and reporting requirements.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Contractual will include timelines, milestones, project management, status reports, corrective action plans, etc. to be adhered throughout the project; implementation of corrective action plan, non-payment of invoices until milestones completed.
