14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will result in higher water levels in ITID's M-0 Outfall canal that reduces the head difference from the adjacent environmentally sensitive areas. Lower head differences will reduce or eliminate breaches in the adjacent spoil mound and will also reduce seepage from these environmentally sensitive areas.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Construction of the operable divide structure will result in achieving the above stated goals but allow ITID to open the gates at controlled rates to satisfy the permitted discharges for flood protection. The structure also includes an overflow weir to address excessive water levels in ITID's M-0 Outfall Canal.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The reduction or elimination of breaches will allow ITID staff to meet its maintenance requirements for the "works of the District" by not diverting them from their normal duties. There are also expenditures that occur as a result of fixing the breaches that are funded out of non ad valorem taxes that can be utilized for normal maintenance as opposed to expenditure that occur due to response to emergency repairs. All citizens benefit when environmental areas are not over drained due to breaches.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The population of the Indian Trail Improvement District serves just over 45,000 residents, which will receive some level of benefit from this project, because many of the special district, county and public safety facilities are in the M-1 Basin Drainage Basin. The M-1 Basin that will directly benefit from this project has 13,944 households which also include the City of Palm Beach Gardens, Village of Royal Palm Beach and unincorporated Palm Beach County. This project will also protect valuable farm land including crop production and equestrian facilities.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit will be reduced or eliminated breaches, saved staff time, and reduced or eliminated over drainage of the adjacent environmental areas. This will also help the FWC in their goal of maintaining a higher water level in the J.W. Corbett Wildlife Management Area. This will also have future benefit to Palm Beach County and South Florida Water Management District by providing cleaner water into the discharge system and eventually even Lake Okeechobee. Success will be measured by the reduced frequency of breaches.
