In order to achieve the intended outcomes, the City of Pinellas Park will conduct water quality improvement activities that include removing built up sediment, debris, and invasive species; ponds will be restored to their original capacity.

By restoring the ponds to their original capacities, the outcomes will include reduced flooding, mosquito breeding and pollutants flowing into larger water bodies.
