a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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To introduce a broader population in Florida to the benefits of a career in construction via introductory education services, the opportunity to upskill and expand introductory skill levels, and to place industry job seekers with employers looking to hire.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction Introduction Education and Training Services, development and disbursement of industry educational materials and course materials, virtual education and training services and job placement.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Florida's workforce will benefit from the education and training opportunities, upskill opportunities, and job placement services. The Florida employer will benefit from the opportunity to expand their service capability by building a larger and more skilled workforce. Taxpayers will benefit from having an expanded and skilled workforce to help the industry meet the continued industry demands. Florida continues to attract visitors and those relocating their lives. Ensuring a skilled workforce to build the infrastructure to meet these demands is critically important.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Grade school, high school, and university and college students. Individuals who are jobless, economically disadvantaged, or at risk. Those who are currently or formerly incarcerated person and any individual looking to develop an industry trade skill set. 800 or more individuals throughout the state will be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Individuals will receive education and training services at a variety of levels as well as job placement opportunities. Data collection will be taken at every educational course, material developed, offering given and job placement made and wage rate achieved.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The program will return non-used funding to the State for deliverables not executed.
