4. Project/Program Description

Clay County would like to expand the Elevation Academy into the 2024-2025 school year to support secondary students who fall behind on credits needed in order to graduate. This program is currently supporting 94 students through to graduation at Bannerman Learning Center. This program is open to students who have below a 1.8 GPA, are three or more credits behind, and are committed to earning their high school diploma. Currently, this program has a wait list. Through 2023 legislative support, the program will open its doors in the evening beginning in January. This project would keep the doors open one more year.

Funds would be used to staff Elevation Academy an additional 25 hours per week (five hours per day). This would allow up to 50 students from other schools the opportunity to make up credits and put them on the path to graduation and into the workforce.

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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Clay County District School's goal is to increase the number of students who earn their high school diploma by increasing the access to flexible educational programming and individualized support.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will be used to staff the existing Elevation Academy five hours beyond the normal school day for five days a week for a school year. Students would be provided with certified instructional support and a school counselor. Students would have opportunities to receive tutoring in a one-on-one or small group setting as they earn their credits.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The students within the program would receive educational services. The general public would benefit from an educated citizenry with the credentials needed to be gainfully employed. In addition, increased education is associated with increased living conditions and health care, which benefit the public good.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This program will serve 50 students in their senior year of high school who are three or more credits behind, have below a 1.8 GPA, and who are committed to earning their high school diploma.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

With the right supports in place, it is expected that 75% of the students who attend on a regular basis will remain in the program to graduation where they will earn their high school diploma. The district will measure success by tracking students' attendance and course completion records.
