To develop a central distribution center for information and services provided by agencies and nonprofits in our multicultural/diverse county. In addition to facilitating planning and implementation of public/private partnerships to create a small business incubator to train entrepreneurs, ESOL programs, financial literacy, college prep, pathway to citizenship education and assist parents.

Can be used by everyone, however, focus on targeted demographic, Hispanic, Haitian & Guatemalan-Maya. Approximately 1.5 million residents in Palm Beach County will be able to access information in one centralized system with over 24% of our population identifying as Hispanic/Latino.
