a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The Town of Surfside's project improves mobility and safety by creating accessible pathways to key destinations like the park, Town Hall, post office, community center, and grocery store. Furthermore, the project will prioritize public safety through community engagement and feedback mechanisms, promptly addressing any potential issues or safety concerns as they arise. This comprehensive approach ensures that the project will not only make strides in improving public health but also in safeguarding the community.
