14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The Lowell area has been identified with soil contamination detected above FDEP's provisional cleanup target levels. Marion County has developed a concept plan to extend a centralized potable water system into the Lowell area which would provide clean drinking water to the citizens within the area, to include the State Fire College and other state-run facilities in the vicinity.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Propose to install the required infrastructure (water mains, valves, fire hydrants, water booster station, etc.) to provide central potable water service to the State Fire College, other state-run facilities, & residents located within the Lowell area.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Provide central potable water service to the Florida State Fire College, other state-run facilities, and citizens within the Lowell area.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The population includes the Florida State Fire College = 7,000 students per year. The project would provide infrastructure to allow service connections to properties along the route, including other state-run facilities.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

By providing a central potable water system, the residents and state-run facilities in the Lowell area would have the opportunity to disconnect from local wells and instead connect to municipal drinking water. The central water system also provides improved fire flow to the Lowell area to improve fire protection.
