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The specific goal of installing a food forest is to create a sustainable and resilient community resource that addresses various societal challenges. Through the establishment of food forests, we aim to achieve the following objectives: improved food security, community nutrition, educational opportunities, economic empowerment, and promotion of sustainable practices.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Community engagement, educational outreach, harvest and distribution, nutritional support, advocacy and outreach, collaboration with local organizations, and evaluation and improvement.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Education of nutritional sustainability, healthy food security, community engagement, reduced or free food costs.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Elderly, persons with poor mental and physical health, economically disadvantaged persons, at-risk youth, grade school students, high-school students, and developmentally disabled. 2000-3000 thousand individuals are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Improve physical health, improve mental health, enrich cultural experience, improve agricultural education and production, improve quality of nutritional education, increase or improve economic activity, enhance individual's economic self-sufficiency. We will measure the outcome with a combination of financial data, skill development assessments, and feedback from individuals, students, teachers, administration and seniors.
