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Expansion of nursing, other healthcare, and related natural sciences programs such as anatomy and physiology will allow for additional student educational opportunities for high school graduates as well as returning students and will aid in providing needed and trained graduates to the healthcare providers and patients in the service district.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Easier access to healthcare services will be available to citizens as a result of this project. Over the next 10 years, the college expects to train an additional 900 healthcare workers for the community.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All recent high school graduates and any others that might be searching for a new career or wishing to update existing skills are the primary target population.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit is the graduation of double the number of trained nurses trained to address the current shortfall in the service district, resulting in improved accessibility to healthcare services for the community.
