a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of this project is to provide multi-use classroom-type space conveniently located for students primarily in nursing and related healthcare programs, and students in natural sciences fields, although use will be available for all college departments. By making the educational process easier for students, it is anticipated that enrollment and success measures will increase.

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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Expansion of nursing, other healthcare, and related natural sciences programs such as anatomy and physiology will allow for additional student educational opportunities for high school graduates as well as returning students and will aid in providing needed and trained graduates to the healthcare providers and patients in the service district.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Easier access to healthcare services will be available to citizens as a result of this project. Over the next 10 years, the college expects to train an additional 900 healthcare workers for the community.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The targeted population is students interested in a career in the field of healthcare. Over the next 10 years, the college expects to train an additional 900 healthcare workers for the community.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Improved access to healthcare services for all members of the community is the expected benefit and outcome of this project. Outcomes could be measured by government workforce and medical regulatory agencies.
