Jackson County is in need of a convention center that can be used for conferences and events. The county has long had a vision for this space and has dedicated TDC monies to a lock-box to use specifically for this purpose which has been saved for approximately 20 years and has about \$2 million in funding. We received a \$1 million dollar appropriation in the current fiscal year to renovate the gym at the Endeavor property. Bids came in at \$4 million dollars which leaves an approximate \$1 million gap in funding. Renovating this facility will provide a premier event space for Jackson County. This will also preserve the historic gymnasium at this property.
