14. Program Performance



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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of this project is to construct several improvements at Lake Seminole's Howell's Boat Landing. These improvements will allow for more visitors to be able to enjoy the landing and provide unfettered and increased access to this unique and pristine water body. The proposed boat landing improvements will allow for increased boating and fishing activity on the lake and serve to enhance the park as a recreational destination that will increase and support local nature-based tourism business activities in the area.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Jackson County will coordinate the design and construction of the proposed improvements. Upon completion the County and local City of Sneads will partner in a coordinated marketing campaign for this facility as a prime sports fishing and recreation area within our community.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Upon completion, citizen's of Jackson County will have unrestricted access to utilize the facilities in the way in which they were intended. Jackson County will preserve and maintain the boat landing for public use for as long as the facility remains in its care.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project will primarily serve the citizens of Jackson County (est. population 48,000). Additionally, with the improvements the Lake will be able to host larger events potentially attracting clients and visitors from several hundred miles in either direction of the County. The facility is located in close proximity to the interstate between several large communities such as Tallahassee, Panama City, Pensacola, and Dothan, AL.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increased revenue from increased events being able to be held on the Lake. (metric: funds generated). Enriching the cultural experience of the citizens by providing a safe outdoor recreational space for individuals and organizations (metric: number of events, happiness surveys). Increase in tourism because of the improvements (metric: number of tourists/boaters that visit the landing).
