14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Funding would be for the design, engineering, and construction of improvements to Hollywood Boulevard. Hollywood Boulevard would be reduced to one vehicular travel lane in each direction, and the remaining width would be repurposed to provide multi-modal infrastructure. Wider sidewalks and multi-use paths would be added on the northern and southern side of the road. Additionally, there would be a proposed roundabout at the intersection of Ferry Road NE/SE and Hollywood Boulevard NE/SE.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The addition of multi-modal infrastructure will allow for pedestrian friendly improvements. The placement of a roundabout at the Ferry and Hollywood intersection would allow for a safer environment for drivers and pedestrians.

c.	What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Multi-modal connectivity, pedestrian friendly walkways, traffic improvement, and safety improvement.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Grade school students; high school students; university/college students; general. The majority of the funds will benefit no specific group.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Decrease the risk of pedestrian accidents by adding ways of multi-modal transportation. Decrease the risk of accidents by implementing a roundabout. Compare number of accident reports after pedestrian improvements have been added to an equivalent time period before pedestrian improvements were added. Monitor the amount of accidents that occur at the roundabout and compare the data to the previously existing intersection.
