#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The conversion of existing aerial to underground provides the ability to promote a safer and more reliable system. Thus, limiting the shut-down or limited access as a result from weather-related events. Furthermore, safety and community health; burying lines eliminates fire hazards, accidents, and safety risks from power outages due to downed lines.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The complete conversion of currently aerial facilities to underground. This includes the design, materials, construction, wreck-out of aerial facilities, and construction management.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Safer, more aesthetic and reliable system. Reduces the risk of limited mobility and loss of electricity as a result of storm events/damage.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Undergrounding the aerial utilities on Highway 98 from the west boundary of city limits to the intersection of Airport Boulevard will help residents, businesses, highway users and pedestrians. Approximately 7,433 customers are served by the three feeder electrical service lines that would be undergrounded as a result of this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Undergrounding utility lines eliminate fire hazards, accidents, safety risks, and power outages due to downed lines. The City is located on a island and is vulnerable to power outages caused by high winds from tropical storms and hurricanes. Residents who receive power from the underground lines will still have power after a major storm because the lines are buried.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Should the City of Destin not utilize the provided funding or a portion of the funding for the undergrounding of utilities in the Phase I project area, the City will be required to return the funding to the State of Florida.
