The purpose of the Redstone Intersection Improvement Project is to realign Redstone Ave and the intersection of Redstone and Brookmeade Dr. to improve access to North Okaloosa Medical Center. The current road alignment creates an unsafe condition for emergency vehicles and patients entering and exiting the hospital. The City of Crestview has completed the design for this project which will improve traffic, provide safe travel, accommodate pedestrians, and improve stormwater.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The realignment of the intersection and construction of the signal will meet the goals of improving the volume and safety of traffic through the intersection.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The realignment of a misaligned intersection and construction of a new traffic signal to improve the intersection throughput.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

There are over 2,500 residential units (single family, townhomes, apartments) that use this roadway daily. There is also an elementary and middle school that have bus routes along this roadway. The most recent traffic study showed the AM peak to be 959 and PM peak to be 1070. The average daily trips were 6,393 in 2021. The number and trips (and individuals served) will have increased since there have been 500 new residential units approved for construction in this area since 2021.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

When properly timed, traffic signals increase the traffic handling capacity of an intersection and can improve the safety and efficiency of both pedestrian and vehicular traffic. A traffic report will be done once complete to determine if the volume of traffic throughput has increased and the number of reported accidents has decreased.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The standard penalty for failure to meet deliverables is a monetary amount applied for each day that the project has extended past its state deadline. It is usually a percentage of the total project cost.
