14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Ocean City Wright Fire District (District) currently houses, responds with, and maintains the only 100 foot platform aerial firefighting apparatus in Okaloosa County (County). That apparatus is aging and is in need of replacement. The goal of this funding is to enhance current fire service capability in the County by replacing dated and aging equipment with new, state of the art equipment and donate the current apparatus to a volunteer department within the County who does not have adequate resources.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Citizens in communities throughout the Panhandle and State of Florida will be the recipients of emergency response from highly trained professional firefighters operating the most advanced technology available.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens will receive reliable fire service response including elevated rescue capabilities, rescue from multi-story occupancies on fire, and high-angle rope rescue emergencies. Additional elevated fire streams for extinguishment provide tactical advantages not available from other types of firefighting apparatus.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Fire service professionals and the citizens of the communities they protect.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The funding will be used to protect and rescue citizens during fire and a multitude of other emergencies. It will protect an area that has a high concentration of military personnel, retired veterans, and a high traffic tourist area. The level of benefit is measured by the availability of reliable and state of the art firefighting technology. Emergencies cannot be predicted, therefore, our measurement is preparedness.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The District may, at any time, without cause, order Bidder in writing to suspend, delay or interrupt the work in whole or in part for such period of time as the Fire District may determine, or to terminate all or a portion of the Contract for the Fire District's convenience. Upon such termination, the Contract Price earned to the date of termination shall be paid to Bidder, but Bidder waives any claim for damages, including loss of profits arising out of or related to the early termination.
