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The city received CARES Act (\$773,699) and ARPA (\$2,220,785) funding. CARES funding was used to support fire rescue and law enforcement services (\$773,699). ARPA funding replaced lost revenue, which permitted the city to move forward with the rehabilitation of Well #1 (\$1,593,869) and Mary Esther Stormwater Drainage Improvements (\$626,916).
