This project proposes to equip Paxton School with a new Agriculture focused building that will simulate current employment opportunities. The building will include Principles of Agribusiness and Management, Agritechnology, and Veterinary Assisting. This pathway will provide hands-on, rigorous career and technical education (CTE) where middle and high school students students earn industry certifications and prepare for the growing, everchanging workforce. Numerous community partners are included, such as the City of Paxton, UF/IFAS Walton County Extension, D6 Farms, J and J Farms, Dogwood Acres Veterinary Clinic, Hartford Veterinary Services and Supply, W-C Feeds, and 2 Gals and A Goat.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

This program offers a sequence of courses that provide coherent and rigorous content aligned with challenging academic standards and relevant technical knowledge and skills needed to prepare for further education and career in the agriculture career cluster.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The content includes but is not limited to career and technical education; employability skills; mathematics; basic science; communication; and human-relation skills.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population includes students in the Walton County School District. 401-800 students are projected to be served by this CTE over the next decade.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

50% increase in Agriculture/Vet Tech industry certifications
3% increase in graduation rate of CTE students vs non-CTE students
5% increase in post-secondary attendance of CTE students vs non-CTE students

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Proposed penalties for failure to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract include withholding of funds and liquidation of damages.
