a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



The operating support will create local educational, arts, and cultural programming, production, and distribution. Original programming will be tailored to educate our viewers about the artistic achievements & cultural uniqueness of Tampa Bay's African-American, Black, Hispanic, Italian, Jewish, and/or Veteran communities. Distribution is on cable access television channels, Spectrum 635/636 & Frontier FiOS 32/34, and worldwide via watch.tbae.net.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

TBAE will program and operate (2) 24-hour educational cable access TV stations; produce more than 100 original television programs supporting the arts, educational, and cultural communities; and make its programming available worldwide at no charge to the viewer via a custom TV app.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

To provide support to local arts, educational, and cultural non-profits and/or businesses by creating specific programming tailored and designed to increase awareness and promote visitors and/or tourism to those organizations and to provide workforce development for high school and/or college students through TBAE's Media Arts Internship program.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Elderly persons, persons with poor physical health, jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons, at-risk youth, physically disabled persons, high school students, university/college students, victims of crime, and the overall general population. For persons who do not have the means or are not in good health to visit places in the community, TBAE brings programming from locations such as The Florida Aquarium to them through our programming.

#### e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

#### be measured?

An increased awareness of Tampa Bay's unique cultural heritage through the development and production of local television programming. To increase awareness and interest in all of TBAE Network's programming as each of the programs produced are with a high standard to improve viewer's quality of education. Raise awareness of environmental concerns affecting our community through established original programming initiatives. Increase awareness of common internet-based scams affecting senior residents in our community by developing an original program series designed to address these issues. Two additional full-time positions will be created to assist in video production, assist in managing and training interns, and/or assist in TBAE's social media and marketing efforts. TBAE Network will track all programming streaming requests.
