4. Project/Program Description

The Washington County Board of County Commissioners are requesting consideration for additional appropriations for a paving project for Dumajack Road in Sunny Hills, FL. Washington County was awarded \$2,500,00 in the state appropriations in the fiscal year 2022-2023. HMB Professionals Engineering Inc. estimated the cost of the project at \$3,562,756 and the county is requesting the balance of those funds for the fiscal year 2023-2024 appropriations. The current road conditions are a safety concern for emergency vehicles, school buses, and private vehicles alike. The Washington County School Board own approximately 100 acres on Dumajack Road and will be erecting a new school on this acreage as part of their strategic plan. Homes by Deltona is currently constructing over 50 new homes in the area with others in the permitting process. These properties need safe, convenient, and reliable access to Highway 77. Washington County is requesting a total of \$1,062,756 for Phase II of the project.
